Wild West Coast

The West Coast is an undiscovered treasure trove of unspoilt beaches.

Along this stretch of coastline are a series of quaint historic towns and fishing villages with names like Lambert's Bay, Paternoster, Saldanha and Langebaan. Salt of the earth residents make this desolate cold coastline their home, where snoek, mussels and crayfish are a way of life and 'bokkoms' (salted mullet strung up in bunches and left to dry) is the local delicacy.

Route 27 is a seafood mecca and a number of open-air beach restaurants offer unsurpassed seafood fresh from the sea, cooked on open fires while you enjoy the sea views.

The little town of Darling deserves a stop, especially in September for its Wild Flower and Orchid show and for its locally produced wines.

The West Coast National park is a world heritage sight with amazing birdlife flowers and views.

HIGHLIGHTS of this day trip include:

- + Surfers coast Milnerton to Melkbos stopping at Blaauwberg and the little Island.
- + West Coast National Park, Churchhaven and Posberg
- + West coast Seafood Feast! (Late Lunch)
- + Back roads of the Swartland through the quaint towns of Darling & Philidelphia.
